Study Area

The Regional Intergovernmental Council (RIC) is the Metropolitan Planning Commission responsible for transportation planning activities within the study area of Kanawha and Putnam Counties. This encompasses the entire Metropolitan Area which matches the air quality non-attainment area. RIC was designated as a Metropolitan Planning Organization in 1975. Metropolitan Planning Organization's (MPO's) are directed by the Fixing Americas Surface Transportation (FAST) Act to develop and publish an annual listing of federally funded projects that were obligated during each fiscal MPO program year.

“An annual listing of projects, including investments in pedestrian walkways and bicycle transportation facilities, for which Federal funds have been obligated in the preceding year shall be published or otherwise made available by the cooperative effort of the state, transit operator, and metropolitan planning organization for public review. The listing shall be consistent with the categories identified in the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP).” (23 U.S.C., Sec. 1201.

These projects are pulled from the MPO's Transportation Improvement Program. The Transportation Improvement Program is a multimodal transportation document required by the US Department of Transportation to fulfill the objectives of the MPO. The content of this annual project list is consistent with projects shown in the FY 2014 - 2017 TIP including project name, project identification number, project description, type of work, and the amount of programmed funds. The format varies somewhat from the Transportation Improvement Program so that specific information can be conveyed. Obligated projects are projects that have met all federal requirements and have received funding authorization from a federal agency. This requires the federal agency to pay the federal portion of the project cost. Obligated projects are not always completed in the programmed year and the amount of the obligation may not always equal the total cost of the project. Cost adjustments are required periodically for certain projects. FTA project obligation begins when the FTA grants are awarded and FHWA project obligation begins when a project agreement is executed and the state and grantee request that the funds be obligated. The principal purpose of this effort is to give insight into responsible government spending on transportation projects and strategies in metropolitan areas to state and local officials and the public at large.

The obligated list of projects is developed through a cooperative effort with state and public transportation operators responsible for tracking project authorizations and obligations. The list presented in this report was coordinated with the West Virginia Department of Transportation and the Kanawha Valley Regional Transit Authority.
